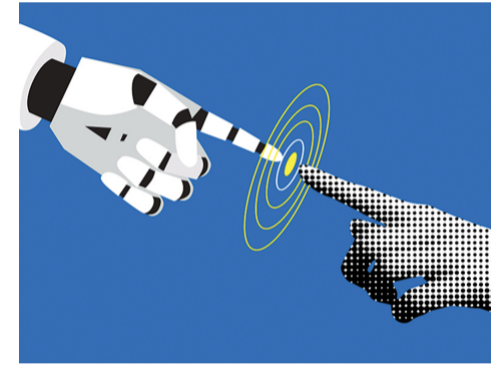
AMPD alumni and students shine at TIFF
